Summary	

University hospital Tübingen is a level 3 hospital of maximum care (according to the National Guidelines in Germany which are different to international classifications) and provides 1640 beds. The average length of patient's stay in the entire hospital is 6.4 days. Annually, inpatients at our hospital are seen 466,000 and outpatients 397.200 times. We offer all specialties of the complexity of intensive care and medicine. All in all, more than 10.500 employees are working across the various disciplines and represent the specialties.

The university hospital consists of four intensive care units at different locations, divided into individual specialist clinics: Medical ICU, Anesthesiology ICU, Neonatal ICU and Pediatric ICU. All beds are available for critical ill patients with the need of mechanical ventilation and intensive care treatments. Our patient documentation is completely digital. We underline the importance of specialist trainings in (pediatric) in critical care and anesthesia.

All intensive care units offer an onboarding concept depending on the nurse's level of qualification and experience. In the onboarding concept as well as for maintaining qualifications, there are training courses on resuscitation training, intubation training and equipment training, e.g. renal replacement procedures etc.

Each intensive care unit offers its own internal training courses on specific topics on an interprofessional basis.

The intensive care team is supported by practice instructors, equipment officers and in some cases advanced practice nurses (some of them are still in training) in addition to the ward managers.
